Re: Form >P= Completion

Under Article XI, Subsection 5(3) of the *Bylaws of the Saskatchewan Land Surveyors Association*, the practical experience of a Land Surveyor in Training is to be reported following the format of Form >P=. Attached for your reference is an example of how the practical experience should be listed on the form. In particular, Council will be considering the variety of experience gained as well as the number of days which involve legal surveys.

In preparing your report, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. The reference to ".. field experience in Saskatchewan .." in Article XI, Subsection 5(3) means field experience working within the township system and does not include work within Canada Lands such as Indian reserves and national parks.
- 2. With regard to the requirement for one year of **practical** experience, >one year= is deemed to consist of one **calendar** year. However, when calculating **field** experience, >nine months= is deemed to consist of 165 days.
- 3. With regard to field experience, 'one day' is deemed to be eight hours. <u>Significant</u> amounts of time spent travelling to and from a project should not be included. However, where more than eight hours are worked in one day, the additional hours may be accumulated as credit. For example, four ten-hour days may be counted as five days of field experience.
- 4. At least two thirds of the practical field experience must involve **legal** surveys. However, even then, Council may reject some portion of the experience if it lacks variety. Every effort should be made to acquire experience in various types of legal surveys.

- 5. Legal surveys include:
 - Subdivision Surveys
 - Grid Road Surveys
 - Real Property Reports
 - Monument Restoration / Reestablishment
 - Utility & Pipeline Right-of-Way Surveys
 - Resource (Oil, Gas, Mineral etc) Lease Surveys
 - Any other type of survey that would be included under the definition of "Practice of Professional Land Surveying" in the Land Surveyors and Professional Surveyors Act.
- 6. A detailed diary shall be kept and made available on request by Council and during the Oral Examination.
- 7. Your form P submission should follow the format of the following model.
